





(3) Place the Bottom 60 and 40 Side covers on the bench seat cushion and push the buckle straps to the center crevice of your car seat.




6 Attach the buckles of your Bottom 40 Side covers, according to the image above.




1 To start, remove the headrest by pushing the release button at the base of the headrest.






7 Attach the buckles of your Bottom 60 Side covers, according to the image above.




(a) Slip on the headrest cover and reattach the headrests. TIP: Starting from either side of the headrest and sliding the cover sideways will help you achieve a secure fit. Repeat same process for all headrests.



(3) Push the rear hook-and-loop straps through the seat crevice. Attach the straps directly to the upholstery of the backseats.



(4) For the Backrest 40 Side, push the rear hook-and-loop straps through the seat crevice. Attach the straps directly to the upholstery of the backseats.
