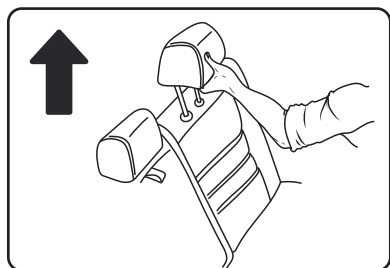
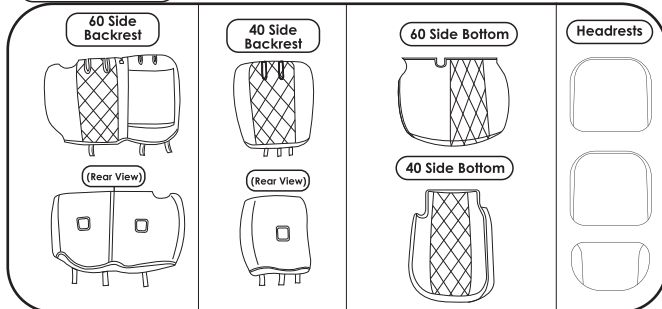

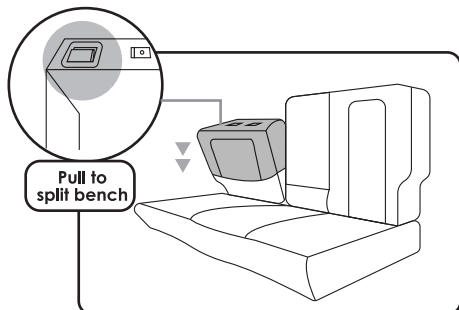
Warning

- We suggest wearing protective eyewear and gloves during installation.

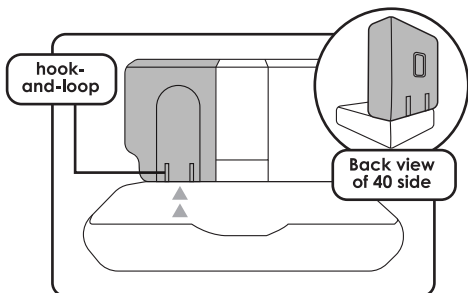

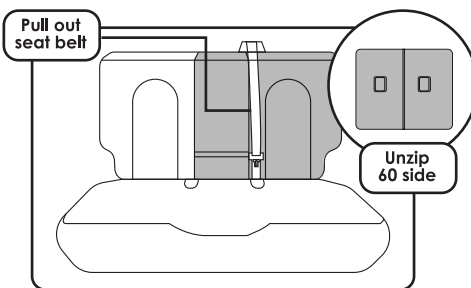
- 1 To start, remove the headrest by pushing the release button at the base of the headrest.



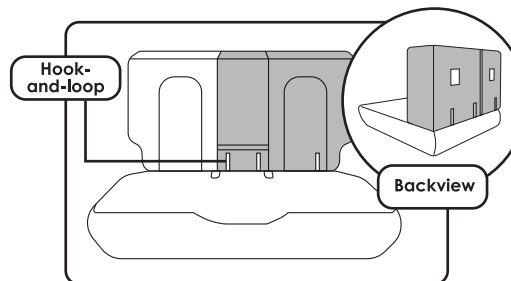
- 2 Pull the 40 split bench seat forward and slide the 40 side backrest cover down.



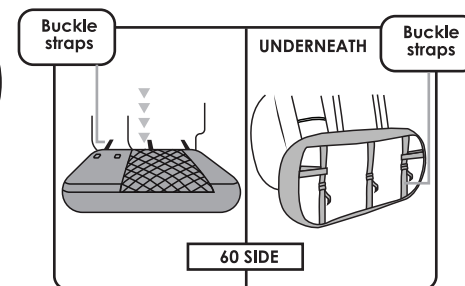
- 3 Push the hook-and-loop straps through the seat crevice. Then, attach them directly to the upholstery of the backseats.



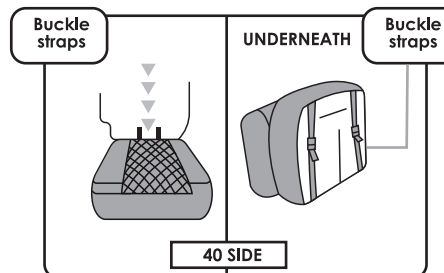
- 4 Pull the 60 side backrest forward, unzip the backrest cover and slide it onto the backrest. Make sure you pull out your vehicle's seat belt before you zip up the backrest cover.



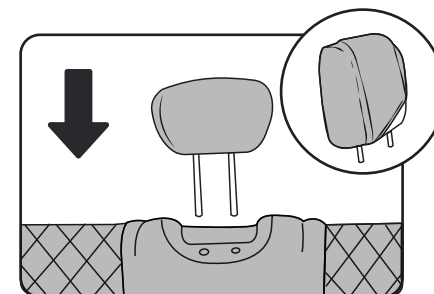
- 5 Push the hook-and-loop straps through the seat crevice. Then, attach them directly to the upholstery of the backseats.



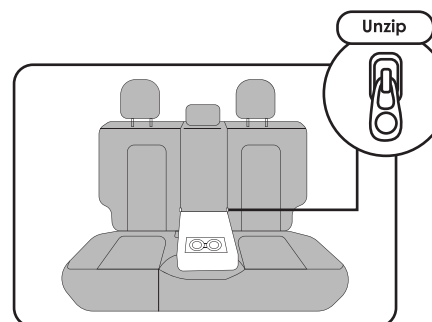
- 6 To install the bottom covers, place the 60 side cover on the seat and push the buckle straps through the crevice of the seat. Then, connect the buckles underneath the car seat as shown in the image above.



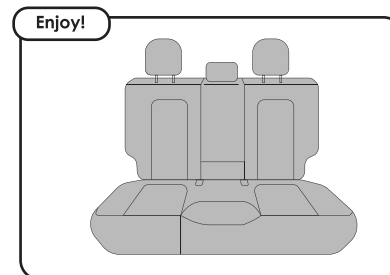
- 7 For the 40 side of the split bench, place the 40 side bottom cover on the seat and push the buckle straps through the crevice of the seat. Then, connect the buckles underneath the seat.



- 8 Reattach the headrests on and slip on the headrest covers. TIP: Starting from either side of the headrest and sliding the cover sideways will help you achieve a secure fit.



- 9 To gain access to the rear center console, please unzip the zipper provided.



- 10 Adjust accordingly, smooth out your custom fit seat covers and enjoy!
